## Hi All

Some of the captains are having trouble understanding the new system on how to fill in the players result cards.
Hope this makes sense.

## 4 player's v 4 players

The home team can pick their order
The away team writes their names on 4 separate pieces of paper.
The home captain picks the names at random and that is the order you play in. 1st (1\&2) 2nd (3\&4) 3rd (5\&6) 4th (7\&8)
If you play with more than 4 players or do not wish to play consecutive frames then the names are drawn singly

## 4 player's v 3 players

The home team can pick their order.
The away team put their 3 names in the 'hat' and are drawn by the home captain to play 1st (1\&2), 2nd (3\&4) \& 3rd. (5\&6)
The 3 names go back into the 'hat' and 2 names are drawn out to play the 7 th $\& 8$ th frames.

## 3 player's v 3 players

The home team picks their order; then the 3 names go into the 'hat' to be drawn by the away captain for the $7^{\text {th }} \& 8^{\text {th }}$ frames.
The away team put their 3 names 'in the hat' and are drawn by the home captain to play 1st (1\&2), 2nd (3\&4) \& 3rd.(5\&6)
The names go back in the hat and 2 names are drawn out to play the 7th \& 8th frames.

## ALL MATCHES: NO PLAYER SHALL ARRIVE AFTER 9PM WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT FROM THE OPPOSING CAPTAIN

If only 2 players are present at 7.30 pm they must go on first.
The scores for each frame must be entered and any breaks recorded. Breaks 30 \& over for minus \& scratch-handicapped players and breaks 20 \& over for other players. It is up to the home team to summit the results. Results must be entered onto the website www.leaguesnooker.co.uk or emailed / picture text to me by Friday 10 pm . Failure to do so will result in a 1 point deduction for the offending team.
