## Handicap Review Criteria

Below are the criteria that a player must meet to be reviewed at the halfway point of the season

A player MUST have play more that 50% of their teams matches at the halfway point.

The players' Win/Loss record is either 75% or more, or 25% or less.

A players' handicap will be adjusted according to the difference in their win/loss record, less 1 point.

Additional points can be added or removed if their average win/loss points margin exceeds 30 points per frame.

A players' handicap can be adjusted up to a maximum of 10 points.

At the end of the season, a players' handicap will revert back to their original, season starting, handicap to avoid "double-dipping" reductions.

## **Captains Suggestions**

All league captains had many weeks to suggest any of their players for a handicap review. These will be based on their individual merits looking at their records, win/loss, margins, etc. They will **not** necessarily follow the same criteria above.

This is the basis for the handicap review process for the 2023 season. Captains have a 14 day right of appeal against any change made.
